STOP private parties taking it for their own interests. Protect our aquifer, the bay and neighborhood greenspaces for the future!

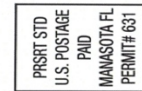
Marlin Conservation Square has been a valued greenspace in the Indian Beach/Sapphire Shores Neighborhood since it was completed in 2000 as a partnership with the City of Sarasota, SWFMD and IBSS volunteers.

Recently, homeowners on either side of the greenspace have initiated paperwork to acquire the land, effectively removing it as a greenspace in IBSS while also threatening a valuable water conservation area.

The 1st public meeting is scheduled with the City Planning Board on March 8, 2023.

Meeting starts @ 10am in the City Commission Chambers at City Hall 1565 S First St, Sarasota. The agenda will be posted on our website once it is published for all who would like to attend and show their support.

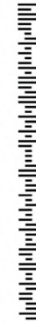
